The **VISIBLE** Study is now enrolling people who self-identify as non-white to participate in research of an investigational medicine for **scalp or body plaque psoriasis**. Psoriasis may present differently on darker skin tones, which can make it harder for healthcare providers to identify and lead to delayed diagnoses and care. The **VISIBLE** clinical study is evaluating how well an investigational medication works for people with psoriasis who identify as non-white.

You may be eligible to participate if:

- You are 18 years or older
- You self-identify as non-white
- You have been diagnosed with or think you may have scalp or body plaque psoriasis

If you are interested, additional eligibility criteria will be assessed by the study doctor or staff.

Qualified participants will receive study-required medical care and the investigational study medication or placebo at no cost.
